POWERED BY PHILANTHROPY, WE ARE BREAKING NEW GROUND ON THE UNIVERSITY'S NEW CENTRE FOR CHILDHOOD STUDIES IN LATE SUMMER 2022. THE CENTRE IS WESTERN CANADA'S ONLY DEGREE-GRANTING, PURPOSE-BUILT FACILITY INTEGRATING RESEARCH, EARLY LEARNING AND CHILDCARE PROGRAMS, AND LAB SCHOOL EDUCATION.

Designed with input from the University's Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) faculty and Children's Centre team, the Centre for Childhood Studies will double childcare spaces at CapU and increase the University's ECCE student cohort by 25%, helping to meet the province's urgent need for licensed early childhood educators.

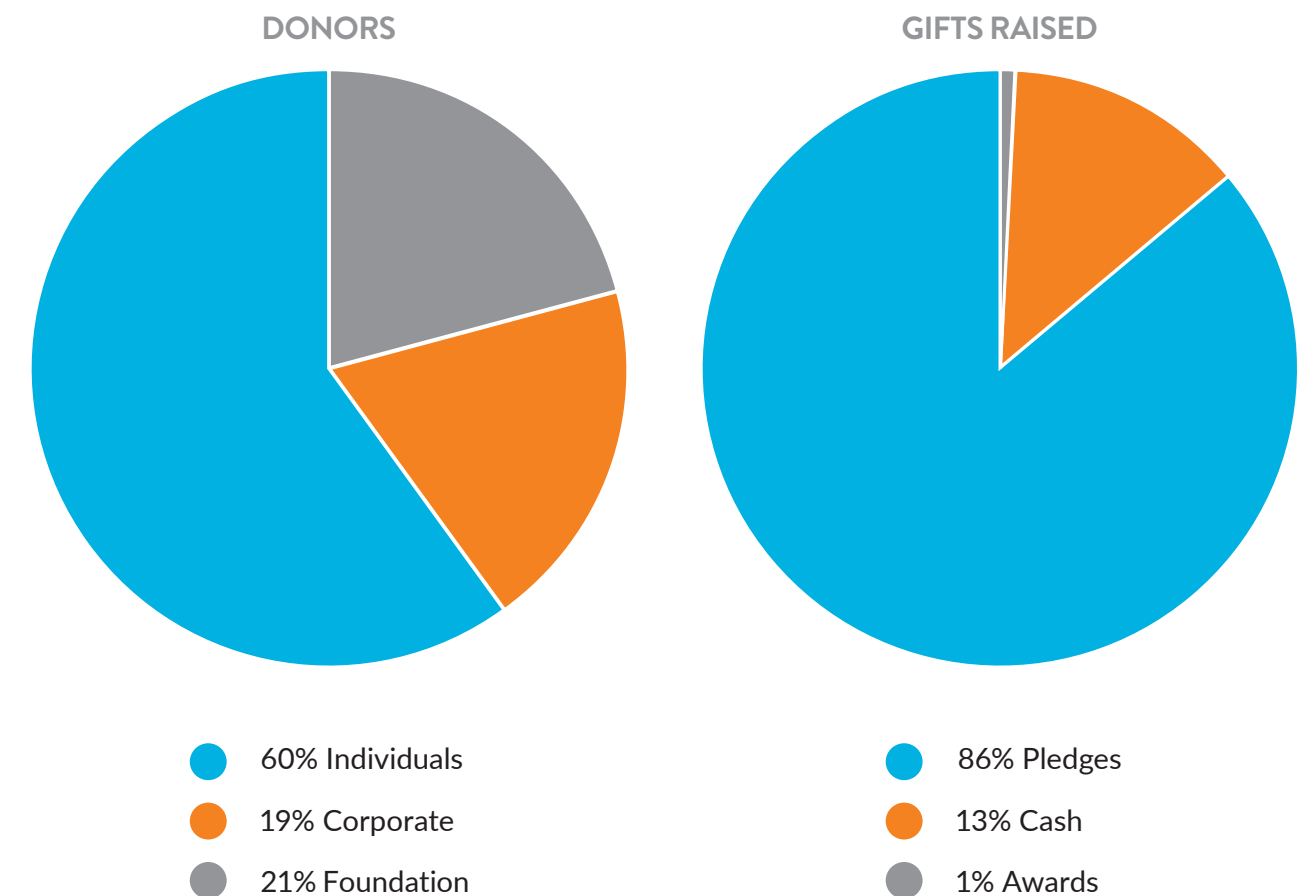
