### **COURSE OBJECTIVES:**

- 1) Synthesis of pre-requisite ABA course content applied to formulation of a clinical research question.
- 2) Categorize and arrange existing literature on an approved clinical research question.
- 3) Assemble content and prepare a critical analysis of applied research relating to an approved clinical research question.
- 4) Plan, prepare and deliver both oral and visual (poster) presentations summarizing the results of your literature review.
- 5) Interpret and evaluate peer literature reviews.

**REQUIRED TEXTS**: Students will conduct literature search for appropriate resource materials.

# **COURSE CONTENT:**

This directed studies course will require the student to meet with his/her supervisor on a weekly basis to discuss the case study and the relevant research literature with the goal of preparing a major paper suitable for publication or presentation and an oral presentation to other fourth year ABA students.
