ARTS & SCIENCES

Successful completion of B.C. secondary school (Grade 12) or equivalent with a minimum 2.0 (60%) GPA calculated on English 12 or English 12 First Peoples and two other academic Grade 12 courses. See the online calendar at capilanou.ca/calendar

CAREER/LIMITED ENROLMENT PROGRAMS

Secondary school graduation is the usual prerequisite for admission to career programs; however, some applicants may enter programs without graduation because of other qualifications and experience. CAREER/LIMITED ENROLMENT PROGRAMS
