EAP for Credit: Capilano University Leads the Way!

EAP 100 (6 credits) and EAP 101 (3 credits) may count as elective credits (between 3 to 9) in other academic programs such as Business Administration and Arts & Sciences. Program areas will determine how many credits from EAP they will accept. *Most other universities do not provide this opportunity!*

Bridge with English 100

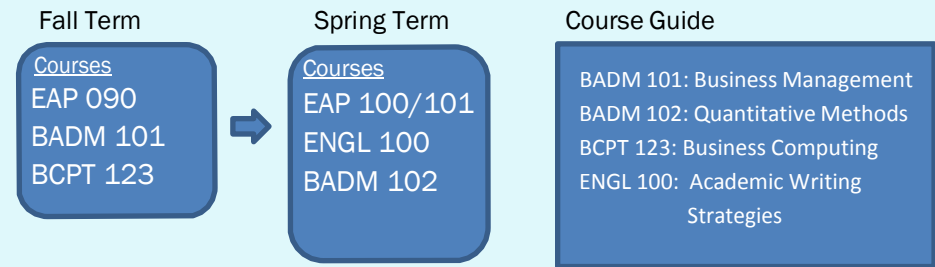
Students not in a Pathway program may qualify to take EAP 100/101 in combination with an English 100 course. (English 100 is not an EAP course.) This is a very special opportunity because English 100 is a course that is required for most credential programs at Capilano as well as universities throughout Canada. Advantages of the Bridge:

- Students are not required to take a placement test (English Diagnostic Test (EDT) or Language Proficiency Index (LPI)) for the English 100 course.
- EAP 100/101 provides extra support for students in English 100.
- Both the EAP instructor and the English 100 instructor *work together* as a team to help students succeed.

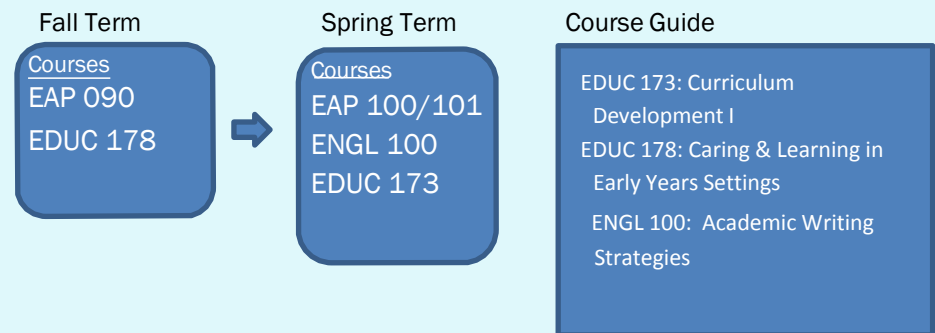
**Pathways: Business Administration
Early Childhood Care & Education**

The Pathways are cohort programs at the 090 and 100 levels composed of specific course combinations. Students begin a Pathway in the Fall term and complete it in the Spring term. Successful completion of a Pathway allows admission to either Business Administration or Early Childhood Care and Education. All other admission requirements must also be met.
