The search for CapU's next president and vice-chancellor continues. Below are some updates on the search process and how we are involving the CapU community.

Launch of Presidential Search Advisory Committee

The Presidential Search Advisory Committee (PSAC) will be established this month to support the Board of Governors in the search. PSAC will interview and identify candidate(s) to be recommended to the Board of Governors. The board will then consider PSAC's recommendation, along with detailed supporting information, before making a final decision.

Community consultations in February

Boyden Canada: Executive Search & Consulting is assisting with the search. Boyden is conducting community consultations throughout February to gather input from the CapU community and refine the presidential candidate profile. More information will be provided once details are finalized.
