STUDENTS' RELIGIOUS OBSERVNCES

From time to time students have requested that the College's academic planning include consideration for the observance of various religions. While it is clearly not possible to close the College for all religious occasions, Capilano College does recognize the importance of being sensitive to the religious obligations of its students.

In this spirit, and if and when students request accommodation for course requirements that conflict with the students' religious observance, it is requested that faculty accommodate such students in the same way as they do in case of other personal considerations, such as illness, family crises, etc. This accommodation would apply to course elements such as attendance/participation and assignment submission dates.

Regardless of accommodation, students remain responsible for all required activities in a course and for all material covered in all classes of a course.
