View from 10,000 feet



Context

- Lowest operating grant funding in BC compared to other universities
- Lowest tuition and mandatory fees in BC compared to other universities
- Expenses increasing faster than revenue
- Not permitted to run a deficit
- Have been making cuts, creating efficiencies, and living lean for nearly 10 years

Context

- 83% of our operating budget is dedicated to salaries
- Sources of new \$\$ are limited
- Government's goals balancing the budget, creating jobs, developing LNG
- Government core review of PSE is underway
- Government Administrative Services Plan is underway

Context

- ▶ \$50 M in cuts to PSE in BC in 2012–14
- Greater student demand for services and support
- Greater competition for limited philanthropic support
- Increased need for partnerships
- Changing landscape of PSE
