# **2014-2015** *INITIAL* BUDGET

- Initial budget ~ est. \$2.5-3M short
- Deferred maintenance ~ est.\$2M short
- Support services ~ est. \$2M short
- Program development ~ ??

Total Shortfall est. \$6.5M +



#### Previous Initiatives to Balance Budget

- Reduction to Critical Maintenance
- Changes to delivery of services
- Reduction in operating budgets across all sectors (admin, student experience, programs)
- Reduction/Re-thinking in program offerings



## **Suggestions from May 2013**

- Lobby Minister / Government –
- Fundraising
- Information Technology
- Add new revenue-generating programs
- Use the accumulated surplus/run a deficit

- •Minimize the impact on faculty and staff.
- •Seek to strengthen university programs as we look to ensure long term sustainability of the institution.
