

Microsoft Authenticator Application Setup Guide

You will need to set up the Microsoft Authenticator (MFA) on your smartphone to access Capilano University systems such as email, Moodle (etc.)

Instructions installing the Microsoft Authenticator application on your mobile device

Simply scan the QR code using your phone camera to download the Microsoft Authenticator application for your operating system (Android or iOS) using the QR codes below. Note: You may need to tap on the link that shows on the screen to be taken to the appropriate location to install the Microsoft Authenticator application.



Google Android devices: download from Google Play



Apple iOS devices: download from Apple Store

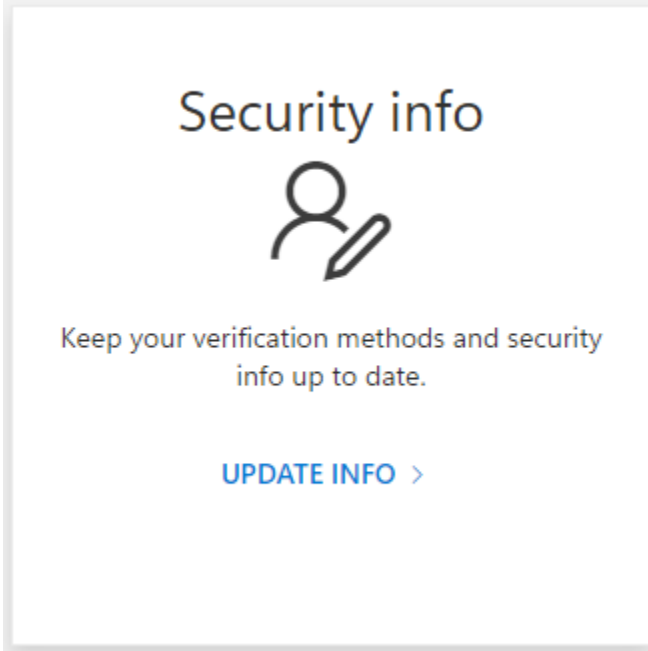

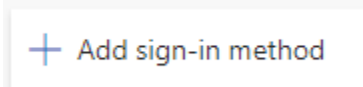

Instructions for setting up your Microsoft Authenticator application

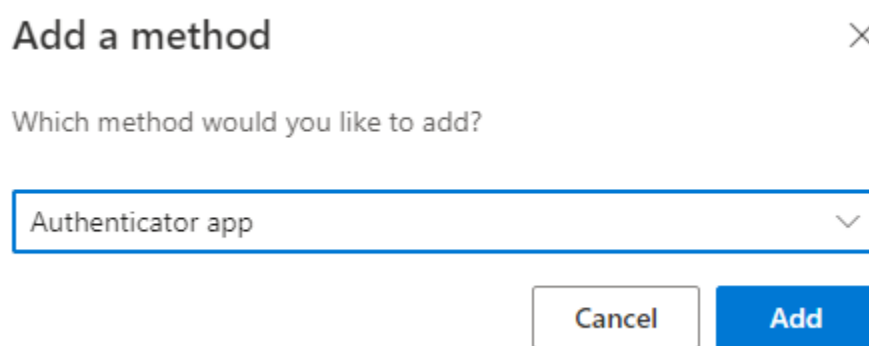
1. Open a browser such as Microsoft Edge, Chrome, or Firefox and browse to <https://myaccount.microsoft.com>
2. Click on *Update Info* under *Security info*. It will look like this:



3. Click on *Add sign-in method*. It will look like this:




4. Select *Authenticator app* in the drop-down menu under *Which method would you like to add?*
The prompt will look like this on screen:



5. Click *Add*.

6. Click *Next* on the Microsoft Authenticator prompt. The prompt will look like this in your browser:

7. Click *Next* on the Microsoft Authenticator prompt. The prompt will look like this in your browser:

Set up your account

If prompted, allow notifications. Then add an account, and select "Work or school".

- You will now shown a prompt which has a QR Code. The prompt will look like the below. The QR Code has been modified for security reasons.

Scan the QR code

Use the Microsoft Authenticator app to scan the QR code. This will connect the Microsoft Authenticator app with your account.

After you scan the QR code, choose "Next".

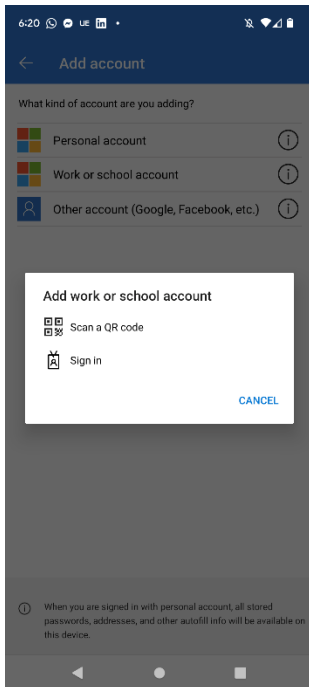

- On your phone, open the Microsoft Authenticator application. It will have an icon that looks like this:

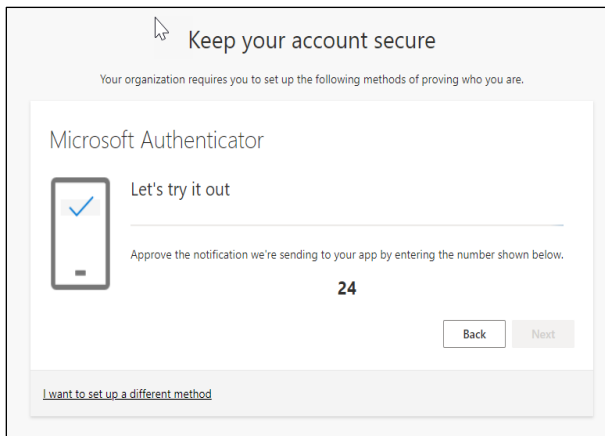


- Click the + in the top right corner of the Microsoft Authenticator application screen. Then tap Work or school account. You will be presented with a prompt which gives you two options, *Scan a QR Code* or *Sign in*. Tap on *Scan a QR Code*. The prompt will look like this on your mobile device:

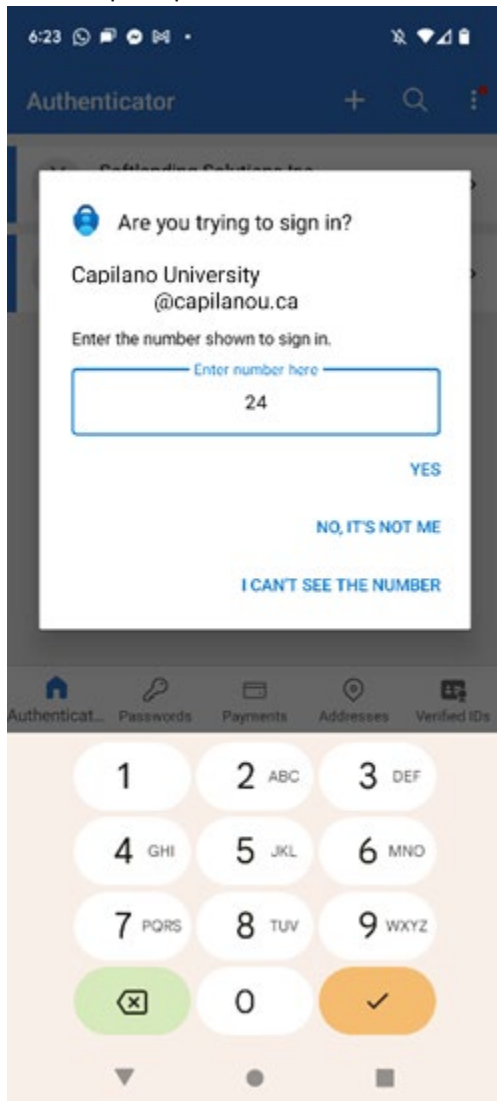


Note: after tapping *Scan a QR Code* you might be prompted to allow the app to access your device's camera. Allow the app to access your device's camera.

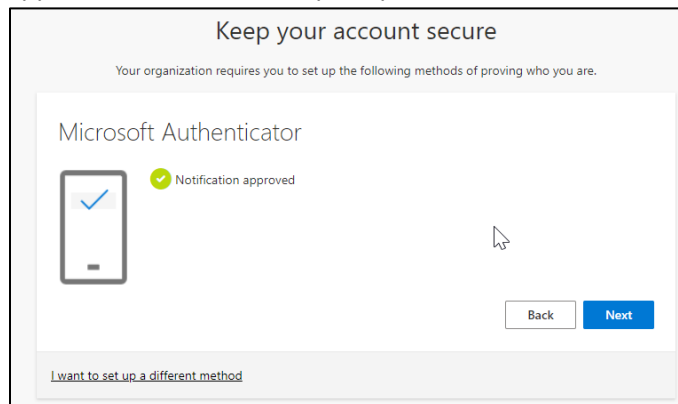
11. Back in your browser, click *Next*. This will bring up a new prompt in your browser that will look like this:



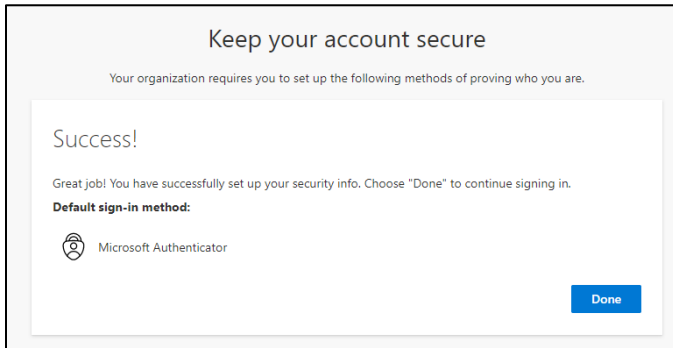
12. Follow the prompts on your phone to enter the same number on your mobile device, then tap Yes. The prompt will look like below.



13. Returning to your browser, if you enter the right number, you will be notified that you are approved. Click Next. The prompt will be like below.



14. If the setup was successful, you will see this in your browser. Click *Done*. You've successfully setup your Microsoft Authenticator application!
