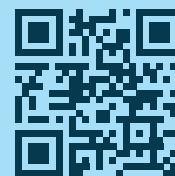


Post Graduation Work Permit (PGWP) Eligible Programs

Working on and off campus

Eligible international students can work up to 24 hours per week off campus during regular school terms and unlimited hours on campus. Most working students are paid minimum wage in B.C. which is currently \$17.85/hr.
