


Bachelor of **Music Therapy**

Music therapists are distinctly talented professionals who use their skills to heal. In the Bachelor of Music Therapy degree program at CapU, you'll gain the knowledge to help others with your musical talent.

Get the fundamentals first

Your music therapy training begins in the third year of the program. The first two years focus on the fundamentals, with courses in musical theory, jazz, psychology, child development and other electives in arts and sciences.

Build your skills and go on practicum

As you improve your skills in music therapy, clinical skills, improvisation and research, you'll also take part in three practicum placements, so you'll test your new skills in several environments before graduating.

Train to use your art as therapy
