

Help keep Ucwalmícwts alive

Come explore the language, culture and history of the Lílwat and other Státimcets Nation People in the Lílwat Nation Language and Culture program offered by Capilano University at the Tszil Learning Centre. Dive deep into Ucwalmícwts, a language of the Státimcets People, and gain a deeper appreciation of how the language is tied to the land and rich cultural history of the People.

As an Aboriginal-funded program, courses are tuition-free for Indigenous learners, but everyone is welcome. Some course fees may apply.

Earn a university credential

Earn a university certificate while learning from local knowledge keepers and speakers and other experienced university faculty. Through language classes, First Nations studies and linguistics classes, you will improve your reading, speaking and understanding of Ucwalmícwts. Two English courses, including one in Indigenous literature and film, will help build practical skills.

Supportive learning environment

Take the program for university credit or audit a course, which allows you to participate in classes without worrying about assignments and grades. Our education facilitators will help you on your journey and connect you to resources to help build your confidence and success. Courses are offered part time in the evenings.
