- **Note**: This program does not accept applications. However, students can apply to the <u>Early Childhood Care</u> and <u>Education Diploma</u> and work towards earning this credential.
- Note: This certificate is embedded within the Diploma and Degree program.
- **Note:** Continuation in each term of the programs is dependent upon the demonstration of satisfactory interpersonal, academic, and teaching/guiding skills. C- is the minimum acceptable grade in all courses within the certificate. Students must also meet the university graduation requirements.
- <u>Residency Requirement</u>: Students transferring to Capilano University must complete a minimum of 50% of their program course credits at Capilano University, the majority of which will normally fulfill the requirements of their final years of study.
- <u>Graduation Requirement</u>: A minimum CGPA of 2.00 (calculated on all program required courses) must be
 achieved to graduate from all Capilano University credentials. Programs may have additional graduation
 requirements as approved by the University Senate.
 - Check your cumulative Grade Point Average (cGPA) yourself using the <u>GPA Calculator</u> on CapU website.
- <u>Timeframe for Completion of the program and Graduation</u>: Students in a one-year program would be given two and half years to complete their program.
