## Comments:

- Students starting this program from September 2018 onwards are able to use this program planner. If you started the program before this term, please contact Academic Advising for an appropriate program planner or you may refer to Capilano University Academic Calendar for your program profile requirements.
- **Note**: Students can apply to the <u>Bachelor of Music in Jazz Studies Performance/Composition</u> or the <u>Bachelor</u> of Music in Jazz Studies Education and work towards earning this credential.
- **Note**: Students whose primary instrument is piano are required to complete 2.0 credits of Secondary PMI in lieu of JAZZ 116 and 117. Students with extensive training in piano may be allowed to take 2.0 credits of Secondary PMI in lieu of JAZZ 116 and 117 subject to Department approval.
- **Continuation Requirements**: To maintain satisfactory standing, all Jazz Studies students must be enrolled in a fulltime course of study (at least nine credit hours) that includes a reasonable number of courses specific to their major (normally three) and must achieve a term grade point average above 1.8.
- <u>Residency Requirement</u>: Students transferring to Capilano University must complete a minimum of 50% of their program course credits at Capilano University, the majority of which will normally fulfill the requirements of their final years of study.
- <u>Graduation Requirement</u>: A minimum CGPA of 2.00 (calculated on all program required courses) must be
  achieved to graduate from all Capilano University credentials. Programs may have additional graduation
  requirements as approved by the University Senate.
  - Check your cumulative Grade Point Average (cGPA) yourself using the <u>GPA Calculator</u> on CapU website.
- <u>Timeframe for Completion of the program and Graduation</u>: Students in a two-year program would be given five years to complete their program.
