- **Continuation Requirements:** Any student whose cumulative grade point average falls below 2.0 (C) will not be permitted to continue in the program.
- **Residency Requirement:** Students transferring to Capilano University must complete a minimum of 50% of their program course credits at Capilano University, the majority of which will normally fulfill the requirements of their final years of study.
- **Graduation Requirement:** Students must complete all courses in the curriculum and achieve a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 (B) or higher in order to graduate.

- **Timeframe for Completion of the program and Graduation:** Students in a two-year program would be given five years to complete their program.
