- Admission: Students pursuing a Minor in Cinema Studies must be admitted to a baccalaureate degree program at the university.
- **Declaration**: Students pursuing a Minor in Cinema Studies must declare their intention prior to graduation <u>here</u>.
- **Curricular Requirements**: Students pursuing a Minor in Cinema Studies must complete both the requirements for the minor and the requirements for their major or baccalaureate degree program.
- **Credential Awarded**: Upon successful completion of the minor, the student record will indicate a Minor in Cinema Studies.
- <u>Residency Requirement</u>: Students transferring to Capilano University must complete a minimum of 50% of their program course credits at Capilano University, the majority of which will normally fulfill the requirements of their final years of study.
- <u>Graduation Requirement</u>: A minimum CGPA of 2.00 (calculated on all program required courses) must be
 achieved to graduate from all Capilano University credentials. Programs may have additional graduation
 requirements as approved by the University Senate.
