- **Admission:** Students pursuing a Minor in Interdisciplinary Studies must be admitted to a baccalaureate degree program at the university. Students in the Bachelor of Arts with a Major in Interdisciplinary Studies are not eligible for this minor.
- **Declaration:** Students pursuing a Minor in Interdisciplinary Studies must declare their intention prior to graduation [here](#).
- **Curricular Requirements:** Students pursuing a Minor in Interdisciplinary Studies must complete both the requirements for the minor and the requirements for their major or baccalaureate degree program.
- **Credential Awarded:** Upon successful completion of the minor, the student record will indicate Minor in Interdisciplinary Studies.
- **Residency Requirement:** Students transferring to Capilano University must complete a minimum of 50% of their program course credits at Capilano University, the majority of which will normally fulfill the requirements of their final years of study.
- **Graduation Requirement:** A *minimum CGPA of 2.00* (calculated on all program required courses) must be achieved to graduate from all Capilano University credentials. Programs may have additional graduation requirements as approved by the University Senate.
