Comments:

- Students intending to declare this Minor from September 2022 onwards are able to use this program planner. You may refer to <u>Capilano University Academic Calendar</u> for profile requirements.
- **Admission**: Students pursuing a Minor in Legal Studies must be admitted to a baccalaureate degree program at the university. Students in the Bachelor of Legal Studies (Paralegal) Degree are not eligible for this minor.
- **Declaration**: Students pursuing a Minor in Legal Studies must declare their intention prior to graduation here.
- **Curricular Requirements**: Students pursuing a Minor in Legal Studies must complete both the requirements for the minor and the requirements for their major or baccalaureate degree program.
- **Credential Awarded**: Upon successful completion of the minor, the student record will indicate Minor in Legal Studies.
- Residency Requirement: Students transferring to Capilano University must complete a minimum of 50% of their program course credits at Capilano University, the majority of which will normally fulfill the requirements of their final years of study.
- <u>Graduation Requirement</u>: A minimum CGPA of 2.00 (calculated on all program required courses) must be
 achieved to graduate from all Capilano University credentials. Programs may have additional graduation
 requirements as approved by the University Senate.
