- Elective Requirements: 18 (6 courses) 100-level or higher breadth elective credits including 3 (1 course)
 Quantitative/Analytical (Q/A) credits and 3 (1 course) Science credits. 9 (3 courses) of these 18 credits (6 courses) must be upper level (300/400).
- Continuation Requirement:

Advancement to the Degree at third year is highly competitive and continuation is based on the following criteria:

- 1) Successful completion of the diploma course work, or equivalent;
- 2) Students with the highest GPA (calculated on grades from all Motion Picture Arts courses in the Diploma) will be offered continuance to third year;

Total numbers of students who are offered continuance will be set annually based on available spaces. Those students who are not offered, or do not accept continuance into third year will be eligible to apply for the Diploma credential if course requirements are met.

• Quantitative/Analytical Requirement: A Quantitative/Analytical course (3 credits) is a requirement of all University baccalaureate degrees as per <u>Credential and Course Criteria</u>.

- <u>Residency Requirement</u>: Students transferring to Capilano University must complete a minimum of 50% of their program course credits at Capilano University, the majority of which will normally fulfill the requirements of their final years of study.
