<sup>1</sup>The language requirement can be satisfied in a number of ways:

- Successful completion of a grade 12 course with a minimum B grade in an approved language other than English while at secondary school; or
- Successful completion of a secondary immersion program or secondary school at an institution at which the primary language of instruction is not English; or
- Successful completion of a post-secondary credential awarded by an institution at which the primary language of instruction is not English; or
- Successful completion of 6.00 credits of post-secondary language courses in a single language other than English; or
- Successful completion of EAP 100 or EAP 101 and 3.00 credits of lower level Arts & Science courses

<sup>2</sup>Only one of EAP 100 or EAP 101 to a maximum of 3.00 credits can be used as credit towards breadth electives.
