- Continuation in each term of the programs is dependent upon the demonstration of satisfactory interpersonal, academic, and teaching/guiding skills.
- o C- is the minimum acceptable grade in all courses within the certificate.
- Students must also meet the university graduation requirements.
- <u>Residency Requirement</u>: Students transferring to Capilano University must complete a minimum of 50% of their program course credits at Capilano University, the majority of which will normally fulfill the requirements of their final years of study.
- <u>Graduation Requirement</u>: A *minimum* **CGPA of 2.00** (calculated on all program required courses) must be achieved to graduate from all Capilano University credentials. Programs may have additional graduation requirements as approved by the University Senate.
